

Ezekiel ch 38 vs 1-8.
 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him, And say, Thus saith the Lord God; Behold, I am against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal; and I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth... Persia, Ethiopia (Cush), and Libya (Libya) with them, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands; and they shall be against thee, and they shall be gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste; but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

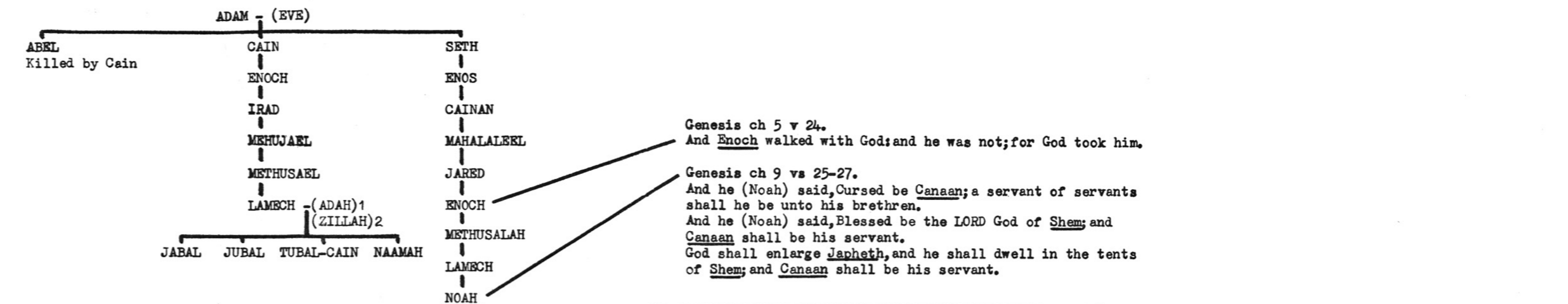
Genesis ch 10 v 5.

Numbers ch 26 v 9.
 ... This is that Elchanan and Ahimelech, which were famous in the congregation, who strove against Moses and against Aaron in the company of Korah, when they strove against the LORD.

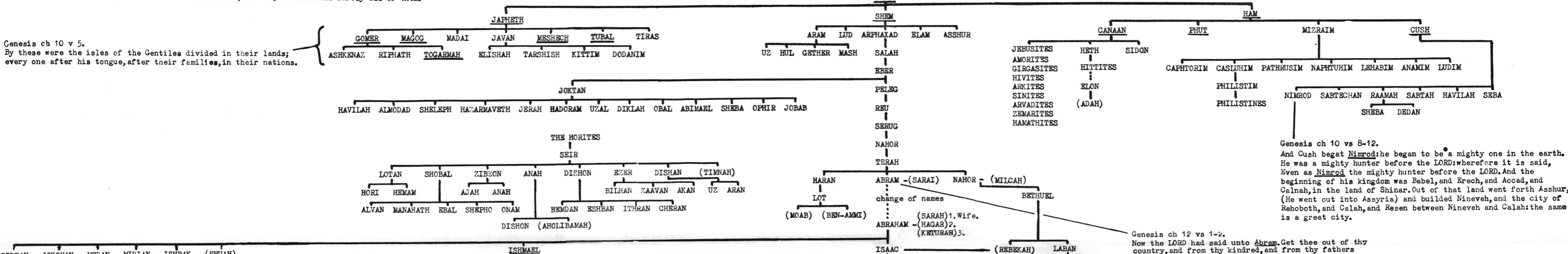
1 Chronicles ch 6 v 10.
 (he it is that executed the priests office in the temple that Solomon built in Jerusalem.)

1 Chronicles ch 6 v 15.
 And Jehozabab went into captivity, when the LORD carried away Judah and Jerusalem by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar.



Genesis ch 5 v 24.
 And Enosh walked with God; and he was not; for God took him.

Genesis ch 9 v 25-27.
 And he (Noah) said, Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be unto his brethren.
 And he (Noah) said, Blessed be the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.
 God shall enlarge Ham, and he shall dwell in the tents of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.

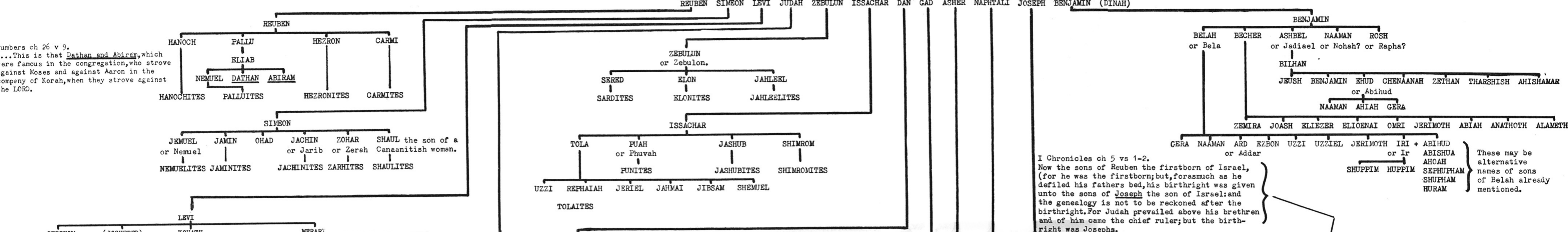
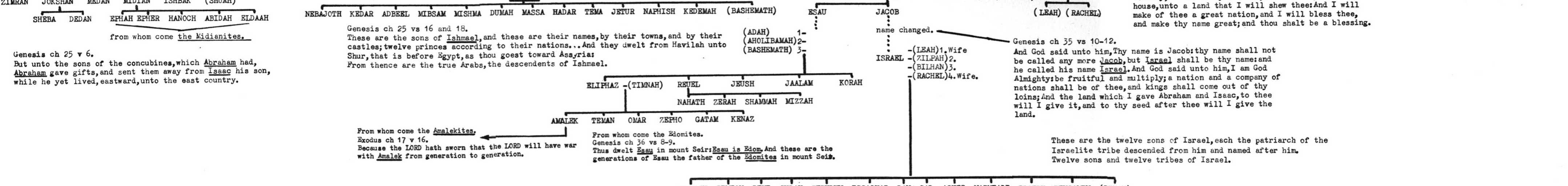


Genesis ch 10 v 8-12.

Out of that land went forth Asshur, (he went into Assyria) and builded Nineveh, and the city of Rehoboth, and Calah, and Resen between Nineveh and Calah; the same is a great city.

Genesis ch 12 v 1-2.
 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will show thee: And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing.

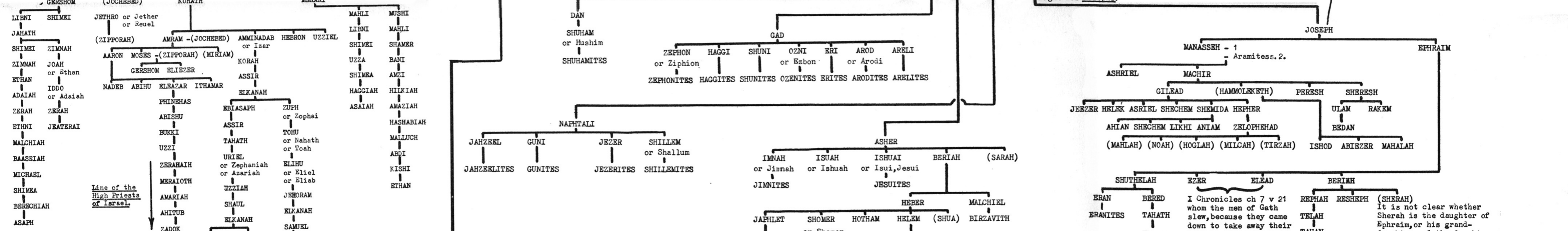
Genesis ch 35 v 10-12.
 And God said unto him, Thy name is Jacob; but thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel; for thou hast striven with the angels and with men, and thou hast prevailed. And God said unto him, I am God Almighty; be fruitful and multiply: a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins; and the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed after thee; and I will give the land.

These are the twelve sons of Israel, each the patriarch of the Israelite tribe descended from him and named after him. Twelve sons and twelve tribes of Israel.

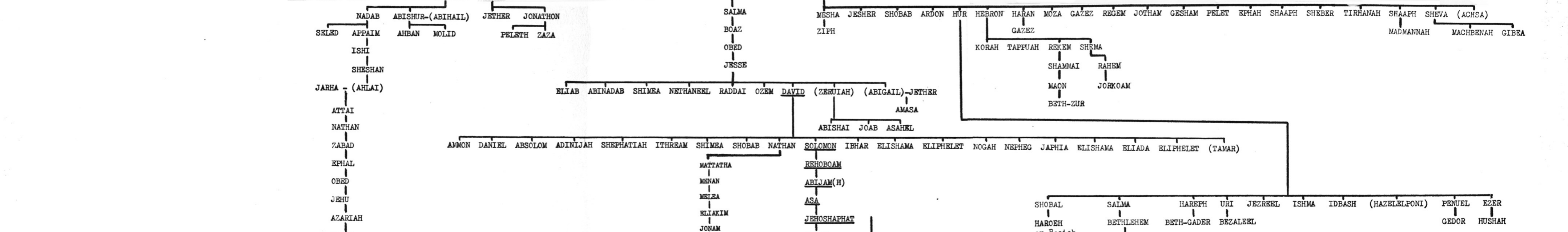
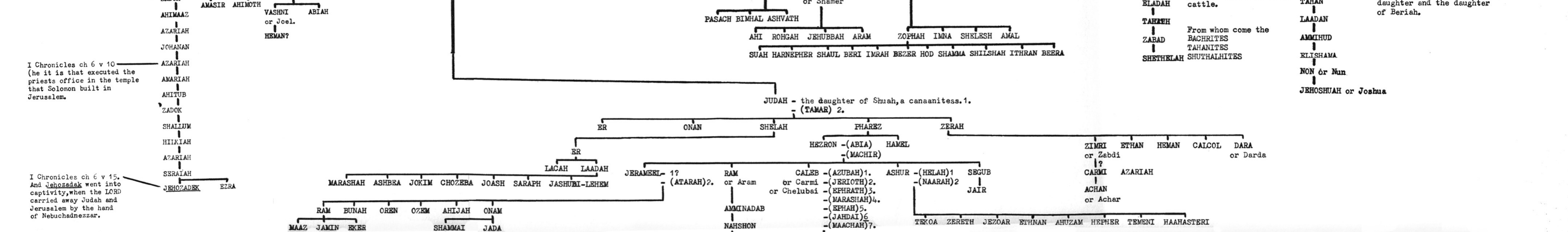


1 Chronicles ch 5 v 1-2.

For Judah prevailed above his brethren, and of him came the chief ruler; but the birthright was Joseph's.)

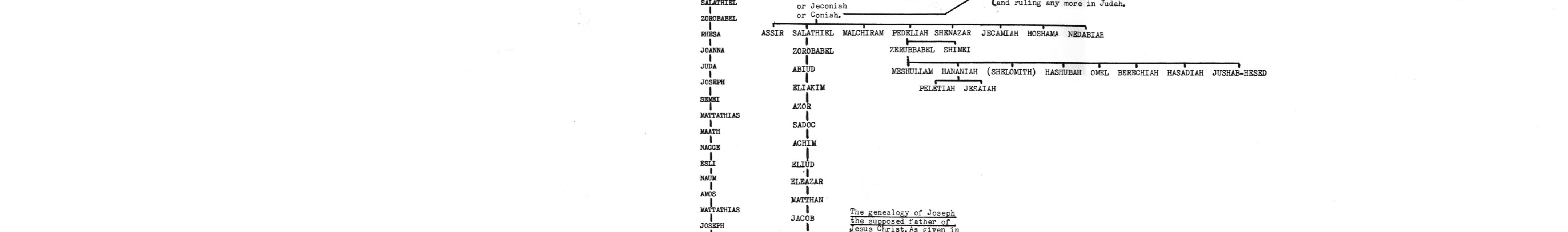
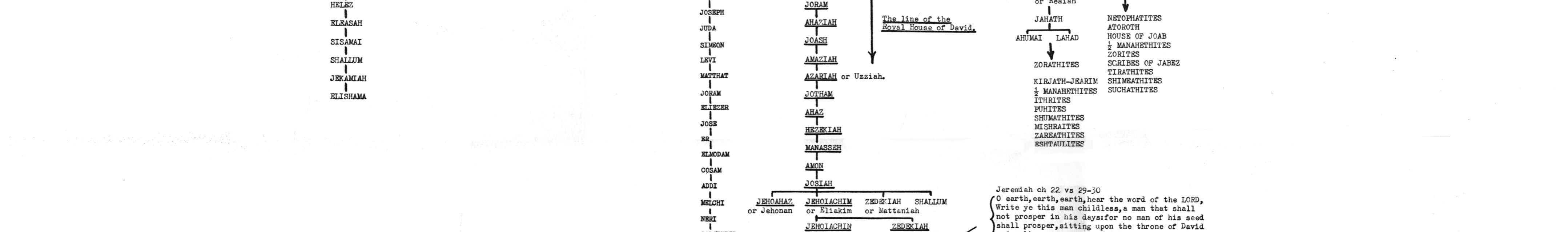
These may be alternative names of sons of Reuben already mentioned.
